



CKSS Dress Code

Our goal is to provide a positive school climate where all students and staff can focus on learning in a safe, respectful, and enjoyable environment.

Expectations:

- ★ Student dress should be appropriate for a learning environment. Some examples of clothing considered to be inappropriate include: visible undergarments; bare midriffs; strapless, backless, and low-cut tops; undershirts.
- ★ Hats are to be removed during the playing of the national anthem, in formal assemblies, and in classes when directed by the staff. For example, hats cannot be worn while participating in indoor Phys Ed activities for health and safety reasons.
- ★ Hoodie hoods are not to be up while in the building.
- ★ Officially recognized religious headgear is permitted to be worn at all times.
- ★ Clothing or accessories with drug or alcohol images or overtones are not permitted.
- ★ Hate-related, gang-related, racist, sexist, or homophobic symbols, images or messages are not permitted on clothing or accessories.
- ★ Clothing must be suitable for technical, laboratory, Art and Healthy Active Living classes. Teachers will direct students in those situations.

Students who do not meet the CKSS Dress Code expectations will be asked by any staff member to put on their own alternative clothing, or will be provided with temporary school clothing to be dressed more to code for the rest of the day.
