

Semester Honours and Honours Society

To achieve honours at the end of a semester, or Honours Society at the end of a school year, a student must achieve an average of 80% or higher. The number of classes used to calculate honours in each grade level are listed below. Students who achieve Honours Society in Grades 9, 10, and 11 are recognized at an Awards celebration in the fall of the following school year. Students who achieve Honours Society in Grade 12 are recognized at their June Commencement celebration.

Semester 1 Honours are calculated at the end of semester 1 (requires: grade 9 – 4 credits, grade 10 – 4 credits, grade 11– 3 credits, grade 12 – 3 credits).

Semester 2 Honours are calculated at the end of semester 2 (requires: grade 9 – 4 credits, grade 10 – 4 credits, grade 11– 3 credits, grade 12 – 3 credits).

Honours Society List are calculated at the end of semester 2 (requires: grade 9 – 8 credits, grade 10 – 8 credits, grade 11– 7 credits, grade 12 – 6 credits).
