

SMART Board Connection

Connecting a laptop to a SMART Board:

1. Be sure you are using a laptop that has SMART Board drivers & tools installed
2. Use a VGA cable to connect the laptop to the data projector; proceed to step 3 once everything is turned on
3. Connect the correct end of the SMART Board USB cable to the laptop, and connect the other end to the SMART Board; green light on SMART Board should illuminate
4. Place SMART Board markers & eraser in SMART Board tray
5. Orient the SMART Board: press the (?) key on the Board's tray, then select "Align / Orient" - press the centre of each red plus sign as prompted
6. Use the SMART Board as required

TROUBLESHOOTING:

Difficulty with laptop / data projector connection?

- Refer to Data Projector Connection handout

Board not responding to touch / tray buttons unresponsive?

- Be sure that SMART Board software is installed & running
(Programs— SMART Technologies— SMART Board Drivers— SMART Board Tools)

Board light staying red / off, not turning green?

- Check USB cable & cable connections
